Directions from train station

Turn left as you leave the station and follow the road with the bus stops round through the new development of flats until you come to a t-junction with Hills Road (Co-op on your left, Costa Coffee on your right). Turn left into Hills Road and follow the road over the railway bridge until the traffic lights (Hills Road/Cherry Hinton Road). Cross over the lights and then cross the pedestrian crossing in front of Hills Road Sixth Form college. Turn right onto Purbeck Road and continue to the end of the road and turn left into Homerton Gardens (at the junction where Abbey School is). Go up Homerton Gardens until you reach a 2 storey building in which the Cambridge Cookery School occupies the ground floor and NEC is on the first floor.

By Car

Please note that there is NO PARKING on site unless there is a visitor parking space available which must be booked with NEC prior to a meeting. There is nearby off street parking off Hills Road namely Cavendish Road, Hills Avenue, or Glebe Road or alternatively there is an NCP car park at Cambridge Leisure Park on Clifton Road which is a 5-10 minute walk.

Arriving by car

Turn off the M11 at junction 11 (signposted: Cambridge South A1309) and head towards Cambridge through Trumpington following signs to the city centre (get into the right hand lane immediately on coming off the motorway). After one and a half miles turn right into Long Road at the traffic lights, signposted Addenbrooke's Hospital ring road. After one mile turn left at the traffic lights (a major cross road) signposted City Centre and Railway Station into Hills Road. Approximately half a mile along Hills Road turn left onto Purbeck Road. Continue to the end of the road and turn left into Homerton Gardens (at the junction where Abbey School is). Drive up Homerton Gardens until you reach some wooden bollards and a 2 storey building to your left in which the Cambridge Cookery School occupies the ground floor and NEC is on the first floor.

By Bus

From the city centre – Emmanuel Street (next to Drummer Street Bus Station) or from the railway station.
Citi 1 or Citi 7 buses going towards Addenbrooke's Hospital or Fulbourn stop directly opposite Hills Road Sixth Form College. Journey time is approximately 11 minutes.
